

From the Principal

On Thursday, November 8, members of a Diocesan Internal Review Team will be at Corpus Christi for the day as part of our AdvancED accreditation. The internal review is a one-day visit to observe, interview staff and stakeholders, and to determine if we meet standards. AdvancEd is a non-profit organization that conducts rigorous reviews of educational institutions to ensure that all learners realize their full potential and schools are focused on continuous improvement. The visit is a critical component of district-wide AdvancED accreditation to assure that we are meeting both the AdvancED and National Catholic School Standards and Benchmarks. All Catholic schools in our diocese will have an internal review before our external review scheduled in 2021. Results from the visit will be available via the Cougar Express newsletter.
