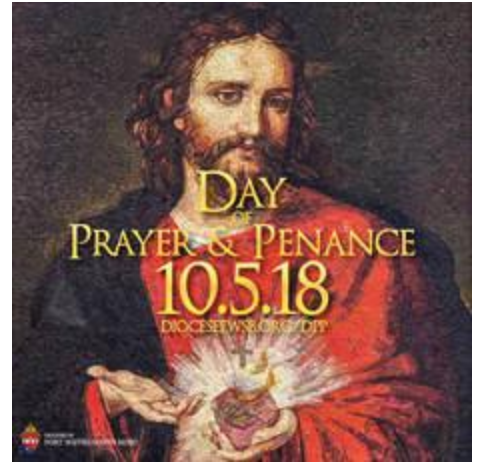


# Corpus Christi School Cougar Express Newsletter October 5, 2018
